



PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS FOR HERDERS

VETERINARY PROJECT: The project was implemented in 2014-2017 in Ulaanbadrah sum and Zuunbayan bag of Sainshand sum of Dornogovi province in order to improve the livestock health and to support the collective initiative of herders through United Private Veterinary Clinics of Mongolia Cooperative and in partnership with the local veterinary clinics. A project team consisting of three veterinarians was stationed in Sainshand sum and provided 814 cases of the examination and diagnostics to 1,600 heads of livestock in 239 families or 78 percent of all the herder households. 8,036 heads of the large livestock and 545,828 heads of the small livestock belonging to 1,429 families were washed and disinfected in 2015 and 2016.

THE PROJECT ON IMPROVING THE WATER SUPPLY IN PASTURES: In order to improve the water supply in pastures, the company has performed annual projects on repairing the herders' wells since 2015 with the involvement of the herders. More than 50 wells have been restored and repaired during the project. Herders submit the request and information about the well in need of repair to the Governor of bag. The request is then presented to the Cooperation Council, after which the wells to be repaired in the given year are selected.
